MEDICAL SOCIAL WORK

Dr Seth left a very lucrative pediatric position in USA and returned to New Delhi India 18 years ago. Presently, he gives 50% of his professional time for community service and academic research projects. He champions the cause of achieving rights for all underprivileged children in India and worldwide. He chairs the Indian Child Abuse Neglect & Child Labour Group of Indian Academy of Pediatrics since 2011. Dr Seth was elected Executive councilor of the International Society for Prevention of Child Abuse & Neglect (ISPCAN), based in Denver, Colorado, USA (2012-2018). At present, he has been involved in the following community and research projects:

Orphan & Vulnerable Children (Street & Working Children program)

For the past 16 years, Dr Seth is working as a volunteer to provide medical care, social and rehabilitation services to street and working children of Delhi. Dr Seth manages two drop in centers for street and slum children in various parts of Delhi since 2000. The rehabilitation services include provision of formal and non-formal education, mobile health services, acquisition of vocational & job skills. His work reached out to more than 25000 orphan and vulnerable children since its inception. At present, Dr Seth is also the Managing Trustee of Bal Umang Drishya Sanstha (BUDS) (www.buds.in), a registered nonprofit organization involved in the education, mobile health care & rehabilitation of underprivileged children. BUDS has initiated a mid day meal feeding drive at Drop in its centers since 2012.

Village Project “Enhancing Health Care Access with Cellular Technology”

Bal Umang Drishya Sanstha (BUDS) has managed rural projects for underprivileged children with the goal to provide health and education to women and children to empower the village *panchayats*, since 2005. BUDS has launched a project “**Enhancing Health Care Access with Cellular Technology**” in village Gandhi Gram Gasera, Nu, Mewat communities in 2015. For BUDS mission, Dr Seth has obtained an Indo-US R03 Grant, jointly sponsored by National Institute of Health (NIH) USA and Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India for this project. BUDS is evaluating a software platform in mother-infant units to improve uptake and coverage of primary childhood vaccinations. BUDS aims to use this novel mobile cellular technology based approach for timely vaccination reminder service to significantly improve health outcomes.

Indian Child Abuse, Child Neglect and Child Labour (ICANCL) group

Dr Rajeev Seth is the National Chairperson Indian Child Abuse Neglect and Labour (I CANCL) group. Dr Seth is engaged in provision of health and education for children of construction workers, immunization project with Delhi Minority Commission and adoption of an underserved village near Delhi to provide health and immunization services. Dr Seth is the national convener of the IMA -UNICEF Training of Trainers workshop on Child Sexual Abuse: Prevention and Response. He has organized several medical conferences and advocacy consultations. He was Chairperson, 4th National Conference Indian Child Abuse Neglect & Child Labour (ICANCL) group (CANCL-CON 2015) December 2015, Wayanad, Kerala. In October 2016, Dr Seth organized a national consultation on Child Trafficking: Medical & Psycho-social services for victims of Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children

Realize UN Child Rights

Dr Rajeev Seth is a member of a high power committee for Convention of Child Rights & Early Childhood Care & Education (ECCE), constituted by Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India. Dr Seth is actively involved in fighting for Rights for underserved children both at the local and national Level. He was the co-author of ‘Children’s Manifesto’, which was presented to all Government officials, Political parties and the general public. He is closely working with India Alliance for Child Rights (IACR) and leading International organizations such as International Labour Organization (ILO) and UNICEF. Dr Seth was the co-convener of the committee set up by Indian Academy of Pediatrics to review the Government plan to set up an ‘Institution of Child Rights Commission.’

Every Child in School

Dr Seth organized a national seminar, “Every Child in School” on Children’s Day November 14, 2004 at All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi to promote the cause of out of school children in India. Dr Seth advocates that education of all children as the only way to remove the menace of Child Labour and promote normal child development. He has presented his papers at several National & International Conferences. Along with a close network over 500 nonprofit organizations, Dr Seth and colleagues advocated for a Right to Compulsory Education (RTE). The Government of India approved a

new legislation “Right of Education Act (2010)”. Efforts are in progress to improve the quality of education for children in schools and enhance pre-school health care and learning. Recently (November 18, 2016), Dr Seth organized an expert group consultation to provide” Comprehensive Early Education & Development: Health care and learning” at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi. This meeting was attended by leading experts in the field in India, along with policy makers, Non profits and academicians.
